# 2022 FNQWG Open & Closed Stroke Championships

## CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and Golf Australia will apply, and local rules in accordance with Mareeba Golf Club and approved by the Championship Committee.
2. The Championships shall be under the management and control of the Championship Committee as appointed by the FNQWG. The Championship Committee decisions will be final in all matters and in the absence of the full Committee, such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision and that decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Committee.
3. Professional Golfers are excluded from acting as a caddy.
4. The Championships are open to: Amateur Golfers with an Australian Handicap who are financial members of a Golf Club affiliated through their District Association with the relevant State body and Golf Australia or Bona fide amateur golfers from other countries.
5. The Closed Championship is open only to amateur golfers who reside in the FNQWG area and must be current full financial members of an FNQWG affiliated Golf Club. Players may be asked for proof of membership of their Club.
6. Competitors will be required to produce proof of their handicap on the first day. (If from a non Golflink Club)
7. GA Handicaps will be used to divide grades. A Grade 0-20.0, B Grade 20.1-27.0, C Grade 27.1-45.4, Seniors - 55 years plus. Juniors -under 18 years.
8. The Championship Committee reserves the right to:
  - i. fix and/or alter starting times in case of bad weather, or for any other reason.
  - ii. vary any condition they deem appropriate.
  - iii. reject any entry without assigning any reason thereof.
  - iv. restrict the size of the field.
9. Should a "cut off" be deemed necessary, anyone not able to be included will receive a full refund of any previously paid nominations.
10. DRAW for both days will be emailed to players, on facebook and the website: fnqwomensgolf.com. Saturday draw by Thursday 7 July, and Sunday on Saturday evening.
11. Players MUST be ready to play, at their scheduled starting time, unless expressly notified otherwise by the starter. All players must register their presence at the course at least (20) twenty minutes before their scheduled tee time. Failure to comply with this condition may result in Rule 5.3(a) being invoked.
12. Completed signed score cards, must be placed in the designated receptacle in the host clubhouse within fifteen (15) minutes of the end of each round. Players are responsible for the correct handicap being recorded in the assigned area on the scorecard.
13. Should there be a rules issue, the player may play a second ball on that hole, and refer the issue to the Match Committee, following play. Any protests must be lodged with the Match Committee, in writing within 15 minutes of completing your round. The Committee decisions in these matters will be final.
14. In the event of a tie for the Championship, the Gross Winner will be decided by a hole-by-hole playoff, until one player has a one-stroke advantage. The play-off holes will be advised on Sunday. Nett events will be decided by the Australian count back method.
15. Limit of 1 Major and 1 Minor trophy per competitor (36 Hole Events) \*juniors and seniors excluded.
16. Dress regulations of the host club will apply.
17. Motorised carts are permitted for ALL players without restriction. Note limited numbers available.
18. Players can bring their own motor buggy.
19. Nomination forms must be completed IN FULL, and be emailed to the Secretary via fnqladiesgolf@gmail.com. Incomplete nominations forms will not be accepted under any circumstances. Payment ONLY by electronic transfer payment to the FNQWG bank account.
20. Tee Times – Saturday & Sunday from 8am from both 1<sup>st</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> tee. Sunday Field is seeded in grades. No exceptions.
21. **Pace of play:** Rule 5.6b. Your position in the field is behind the group in front of you, not in front of the group behind. Any group deemed to be slowing the field will be given one warning, and any groups not complying with the pace of play policy, may be penalised accordingly. READY GOLF is encouraged.
22. The use of R&A approved measuring devices is allowed. Players using a phone App for distance measuring, or to check a rule, will need to inform their marker prior to play. No phone use unless in an emergency, or to ask for a ruling on a rules issue.
23. Event Conditions of Play will be available at the 1<sup>st</sup> round of the event.
24. The Golf Queensland Code of Conduct will bind female golfers.
25. Any matter not mentioned, is at the discretion of the FNQWG Championship Committee.
26. Refunds of fees for Players who withdraw, will be at the discretion of the Committee.
27. NOTE – arrangements may be changed to comply with COVID Safe rules.
